

Secondary Scholarship Enrichment and CAS Programme

Students enrolled a our scholarship programme will be given opportunities beyond the standard academic and CAS (Community, Activity and Service) offering.

Scholarship students will receive an enhanced enrichment programme, detailed below:

- Bespoke, 'invitation-only' access to visits, workshops, and lectures.
- An allocated learning mentor, and regular mentor meetings.
- Access to enhanced skill development workshops

Secondary Scholarships

High Performing Academic Scholarships



Academic scholars should be able to demonstrate strong all-round academic performance across the core subjects, enabling them to think critically and problem solve.

Creative Arts Scholarships



Creative Arts scholars are expected to demonstrate artistic talent and creativity both at home and school. They should be able to showcase a range of work across their discipline

Sports Scholarships

Sports scholars should be reliable, committed, enthusiastic energetic sports people who may excel in one sport and are highly proficient in many sports



STEM Scholarships



STEM scholars should be inquisitive and curious about Science and Maths and be able to apply their scientific and mathematical skills and knowledge to creating inventions and solving problems

Supporting documentation to include at least one of the following:

- Cat4 report
- GL assessment report
- School Academic report
- Photographs or videos of sporting excellence
- Examples of creative artwork
- Examples of extended projects undertaken

Process for Application

STEP 1	Families complete an application form: <u>AHBS Scholarships 2024-2025</u> along with evidence to support the application.
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STEP 2	Scholarship committee comprising Heads of School and ISP director of learning meet to shortlist.
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STEP 3	Shortlisted candidates are invited to school for an interview and scholarship taster programme, which will include a variety of centre based assessments.
STEP 4	Submission of external examination results for IB scholars
STEP 5	Successful applicants will be notified when the scholarship window closes.
