They should be globally minded with a drive to make a difference in our world whilst fostering a love for learning through inquiry, with the ability to care for others and our planet.







Supporting documentation to include a 1 minute video from the applicant, together with at least one of the following:

- Cat4 report
- GL assessment report
- School Academic report
- Photographs or videos of sporting excellence
- Examples of creative artwork
- Examples of extended projects undertaken
- Examples of community engagement and development

IB Diploma Scholarships Enrichment and CAS Programme

Process for Application

STEP 1

Family completes an initial expression of interest:

STEP 2

Admissions contact with specific application details. Applicants email supporting documents to scholarships@ahbs.ae

STEP 3

Scholarship committee comprising Heads of School and ISP director of learning meet to shortlist.

STEP 4

Shortlisted candidates are invited to school for an interview and scholarship taster programme, which will include a variety of centre based assessments.

STEP 5

Submission of external examination results for IB scholars

STEP 6

Successful applicants will be notified when the scholarship window closes.
