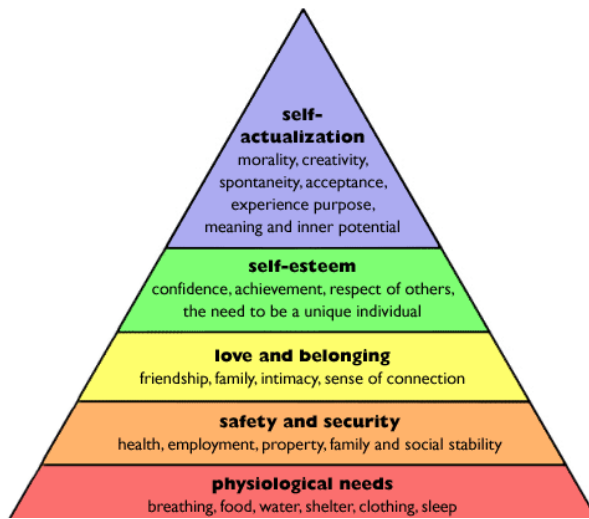

Creating a new community of learners:

During staff training sessions this week I have reflected with staff on Maslow's hierarchy of needs.





Due to the nature of returning to school during a global pandemic, naturally the biggest focus has been on safety and health. We have worked exceptionally hard to meet the high standards set out by the ADEK compliance team, and we submit a daily report to confirm our adherence to these high standards of health and safety. All of these measures have reassured our community; we feel safe and confident in our school environment.

With these measures in place, we are now developing our community’s sense of belonging- becoming part of the Aspen Heights learning community. In class your child’s teacher will be working on ensuring your child feels part of their class, is getting to know their classmates and feels secure and confident. This is essential in ensuring their learning is as effective as possible- happy children learn more!

As a community school, ensuring families and staff feel part of the ‘Aspen family’ is crucial to our unique atmosphere at Aspen.
